



Snakebite Relief Program - Training Courses

SRP is currently offering two training courses on snakes and snakebite management, the overall scope is to equip the participants with the knowledge and the practical skills to prevent and manage snake encounters and, most importantly, to know what to do in case of a snakebite.

- The Snakebite Safety Course doesn't include snake handling and exercises with real snakes; it is therefore open to anyone.
- The Safe Snake Handling and Removal Course is for serious and dedicated individuals, it includes some venomous snake handling and therefore is not suitable for people under 18, people with a snake phobia and people with physical disabilities.

Depending on the location and the availability, the courses can be spread out, achieving the total hours of the course in two weeks or a month.

Along with the courses it is possible to buy pre-made first aid kits specific for snakebite and snake handling equipment.

Upon completion of the course, a certificate will be awarded to the participants, and a certification for the business as "snake and snakebite trained".

SSC - Snakebite Safety Course	SSHRC - Safe Snake Handling and Removal Course
<p>2 full days (16 hours)</p> <p>This course provides a complete training on snakes and snakebite prevention; from how to identify dangerous snakes, how to keep your home and workplace snake-free, what to do in case of snakebite and a snake encounter.</p> <p>A certificate will be awarded to all the participants at the end of the course.</p>	<p>3 full days (24 hours)</p> <p>This course covers all the topics and exercises of the Snakebite Safety Course, providing more in depth information about snakes and a whole day dedicated to snake handling and removal. The participants will learn to move and trap snakes with the aids of tools such as snake hooks, grabs, bags and boxes, and not by hands.</p> <p>The certificate will be awarded only to participants that will pass the final practical and written test.</p> <p>Maximum participants: 6</p> <p>Participants that successfully completed the Snakebite Safety Course, can complete this course in 12 hours, (1.5 days), as long as they do it within a year.</p>

Course topics and activities:

Day 1	
Introduction:	SRP project and mission, Snakebite problem in Cambodia, Pre-training questionnaire.
General knowledge:	Snake biology and ecology, introduction to venom; what is venom and why snakes have it.
Snake Identification:	Most common snakes in Cambodia with focus on the most dangerous species, how to identify dangerous snakes, group, and individual exercises.
Preventing snakebite:	Human-snake conflict: common risky activities, seasonal variation, and other risk factors, prevention, and risk management.
Snake encounter management:	Remote safe removal method and protocol, case scenario analysis.
Practical exercise of snake identification	Outdoor activity (when possible). This activity aims to create spatial awareness on safety distance and to simulate real snake encounters.

Day 2	
Snakebite management:	First aid, what to do and case scenarios, introduction to first aid kit for snakebite, what to have ready and how to use it.
Practical activity:	First Aid scenario for snakebite; demonstration and group activity: practical application of first aid on a snakebite victim, implementing the protocol and applying bandages.

SSHRC

Introduction to handling snakes:	Why and when handling snakes, safety and risks, types of venoms and how they work.
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Day 3 – only for SSHRC	
Handling snakes	Equipment and techniques
Handling snakes	Dangerous species behaviour and abilities, safety measures and protocols.
Handling snakes; practical activity:	Snake handling demonstration from the trainer and practical exercises in different scenario for: Vipers and Pythons Each participant will try to relocate a snake to a bag/bin and release it back.
Handling snakes; practical activity:	Snake handling demonstration from the trainer and practical exercises in different scenario for: Colubrids Each participant will try to relocate a snake to a bag/bin and release it back.

Written and practical final test Closure and certificate ceremony
